Dear Senator Brandis
And Susan Cochrane

I am an ex Liberal Party member now working as an advisor to One Nation in the Senate as they listen ... The Liberals don't and will lose government because of this. You know they will lose under Turnbull unless things change.

In today's Senate question time you made the statements below in response to a question from One Nation Senator Peter Georgiou in relation to Bank issues:

"What we are doing is taking action that will be much more effective and immediate (than a Royal Commission). Let me run you through what we are doing. We've set up a new one-stop-shop dispute resolution body to ensure that consumers and small business can access fair compensation straightaway—not years into the future after a royal commission that might go for five years but straightaway."

Liberals have not set up the one stop shop yet. Fair Compensation is NOT available.

It is only a proposal and has not been put before the Senate.

Compensation limits are only set at \$1m and you know that many of the cases involve damages far in excess of that limit. The Banks steal \$10m but only repay \$1m. Not much justice in that!

I attach details in my case:

A receivers memorandum attached records **David Nolan, Head of Legal and Government Affairs at Bankwest** as saying **"sink boots into customer"** they did this in misleading documents they sent to a Senate that were at the time withheld from us. This is corporate thuggery.

Bankwest senior managers David Gilbert and Les Nolan were complicit in Perjury at a Senate Inquiry in 2012.

There was dishonest and corrupt conduct by Bankwest appointed receiver Mark Englebert of FTI Consulting,. Senior Bankwest officers knew of this and yet failed to act.

Brian Benari the CEO of Challenger acted dishonestly and was involved in this case.

Ian Narev The CEO and Catherine Livingstone Chairman of Commonwealth Bank as well as Anna Bligh chairman of the Australian Bankers Association are aware of this case as is Liberal Senator Mathais Corrmann.

I request that you instruct Bankwest to release to me the internal investigation report they did on this case (which until now they have refused to do), all documents in relation to this case and to appoint an independent Arbitrator to investigate and to release the results of any inquiry.

You think Banks are squeaky clean with nothing to hide ... Please take a look at this case and see what you think then.

I work at Parliament house when Senate sits, Am here this week and could meet to discuss.
